How we can help

Capecare provides a range of personalised support at home throughout the Capes region. We can assist with:



Personal care – showering and dressing, personal hygiene, skin and nail care, hair care, make-up and shaving, medication prompts, welfare checks



Gardening and home maintenance



Shopping and support with community connections



Domestic assistance – cleaning, laundry, meal preparation



Respite for Carers – both at home and in a private room at our Cottage Respite (transport available)



Group Social support at our interactive Busselton Social Centre (transport available) offering full day or half day depending on client needs



Allied health services – physiotherapy and occupational therapy



Nursing services – wound care, chronic disease management



Group wellness and reablement classes provided by our partners Concentric in our state-of-the-art rehabilitation centre in Busselton.

Tailored private services

Capecare can also offer our services for private fees, and as such they don't need an assessment and can commence as soon as needed. This can be useful in situations when family or carers are away for short periods, while you are awaiting package funded services, to top up your Government subsidised services, or still need support if you are not eligible for Government subsidised services.



Government assistance options available

Government subsidised home care can be accessed through the Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP), or through a Home Care Package (HCP).

The Commonwealth Home Support Program provides entry level support for people needing a small amount of care which will allow them to continue living independently and safely in their own home. It works best for people who may just need one or two services.

Home Care Packages suit people with low to more complex care needs. There are four levels of funding, each with different funding amounts. The amount of funding received is based on their care needs.

Level 1 supports people with basic care needs

Level 2 supports people with low level care needs

Level 3 supports people with intermediate care needs

Level 4 supports people with high level care including care and support for people with a diagnosis of dementia.

How to access home care:

1. Contact Capecare's helpful Community team on 9750 2097 to guide and assist you through the process to access aged care services.
2. Contact the Government's My Aged Care Service on 1800 200 422 to request eligibility testing and receive an assessment or visit www.myagedcare.gov.au and follow the prompts to assessment.
3. A Letter will be sent to you from My Aged Care confirming the details of your assessment and your eligible home care.
4. Make contact with Capecare's community team again to discuss your approved home care.
5. We'll make a plan with you to suit your needs.
